In this Co-op Conversation, United Farmers of Alberta Chief Corporate Affairs Officer Bob Fink will discuss UFA's Democratic Structure Review, a top-to-bottom process review of its material governance practices occurring every 10-years. He will also share some lessons and considerations from this review process.
